SUMMER MUSIC CAMP

Rejoice in the Lamb!

Trinity Church of Kirkland, WA is sponsoring its 6th annual Summer Music Camp from **Monday, June 23 through Saturday, June 28**. The camp will be held at Trinity Lutheran Church, Lynnwood: 6215 196th St. SW (corner of 196th and highway 99 behind Trader Joe's and James' Village). Classes run from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm, Monday through Friday (please note that Friday's classes will run until 4pm.) On Saturday, June 28 there will be a dress rehearsal at 1:00pm, followed by the final concert beginning at 3:30 pm.

The summer camp is being offered as a ministry of Trinity Church. To help offset some of the expenses, a minimal tuition will be required: **\$50.00 per student (\$125.00 max per family)** if registered by **Monday, May 12**. Registration received after May 12 will cost **\$75.00 per student (\$150.00 max per family)**. If your family is unable to afford this expense, please contact me directly as we do not wish for money to be a hindrance to participation. Children need not belong to Trinity Church in order to attend. The camp is multi-tiered to service two different age groups: (1) grades 4-6, and (2) grades 7-12; these refer to grades completed. Class offerings will include the following:

Choir Bible "The Lamb of God" Score Analysis Folk Dance

The theme of this year's camp is *Rejoice in the Lamb*. Students will sing settings of poetry about and to the Lamb of God, Jesus Christ. Composers will include Britten, Vaughan Williams, Fauré, Duruflé, and Bach. The various classes all stem from the choral literature which the students will study and sing so that they may examine the music from various angles (Scriptural, musical, conceptual, etc.).

Instructors include the following:

- **David Erb:** DMA in choral conducting, University of Wisconsin-Madison; MM in choral conducting, Westminster Choir College; BM in music education, UW-Madison. He has taught at Lawrence University (Appleton, WI) and Bucknell University (Lewisburg, PA). Dr. Erb is the music director at Trinity Church.
- **Todd O'Connor:** MM in Music History and MLIS Library Science, UW-Milwaukee; BM in music education, Wheaton College. He taught music in WI for nine years and is currently the director of music at Crossroads Presbyterian Church of Mequon, WI.
- **Jenee O'Connor:** BM in music education, Lawrence University. In addition to teaching music in WI for nine years, Jenee sang with the Dale Warland singers. Mrs. O'Connor is co-director of music, along with her husband Todd, at Crossroads Presbyterian Church in Mequon, WI.
- **Kent Young:** MM in choral conducting, Colorado State University; BA in vocal performance, Bethany College. Mr. Young is music director at Christ Church, Spokane and teaches at The Oaks Classical Christian Academy.
- **Dave Hatcher:** Greyfriar's Hall for Pastoral Studies; BA from Washington State University. Mr. Hatcher is the pastor of Trinity Church and teaches at Providence Classical Christian School.
- **Julie Letsche:** former principle dancer with Tennessee Ballet; trained with both Boston Ballet and Atlanta Ballet. Mrs. Letsche has performed in numerous ballets and musicals around the world. She has taught all levels and forms of dance including tap, jazz, modern, theatrical, social dancing and ballet. Mrs. Letsche is sought after by musical theater companies across the country as a choreographer and performer.

As this is a day camp, students should bring their own lunch (cold: no microwave available) and water bottle. Additionally, each student should bring their own Bible and a pencil. Binders and music will be supplied. If you plan on having one or more of your children attend the camp, please fill out the attached registration form and emergency release form and mail them to the address listed at the bottom of this page with an enclosed tuition check made payable to *Trinity Church*. It is important that a faithful commitment is made to attending so that we can order the proper amount of materials and plan appropriately. Thank you for your thoughtful consideration ahead of time. **Students are expected to attend the entirety of the camp** (i.e. all five days of classes, the dress rehearsal, and the concert).
